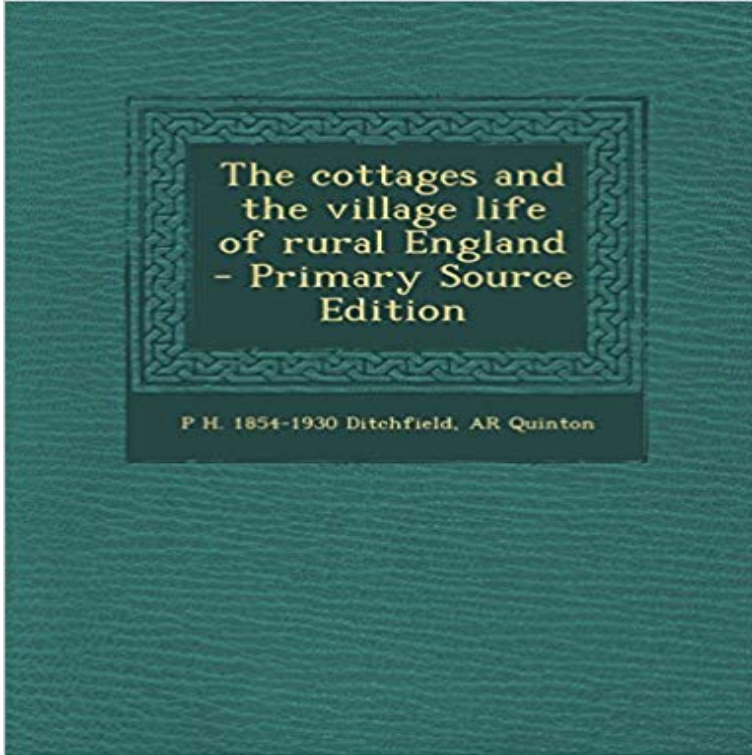


# The Cottages and the Village Life of Rural England - Primary Source Edition
