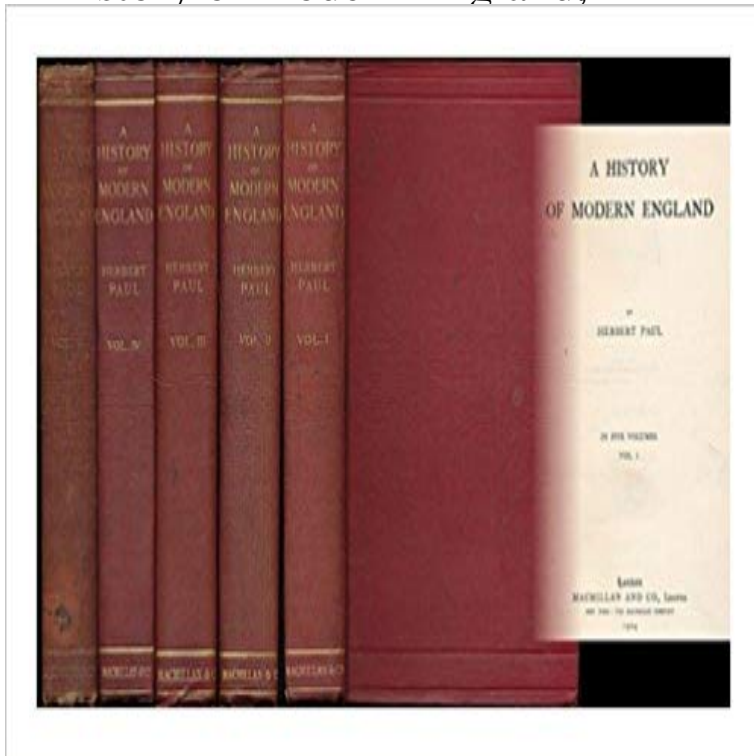


A history of modern England,
