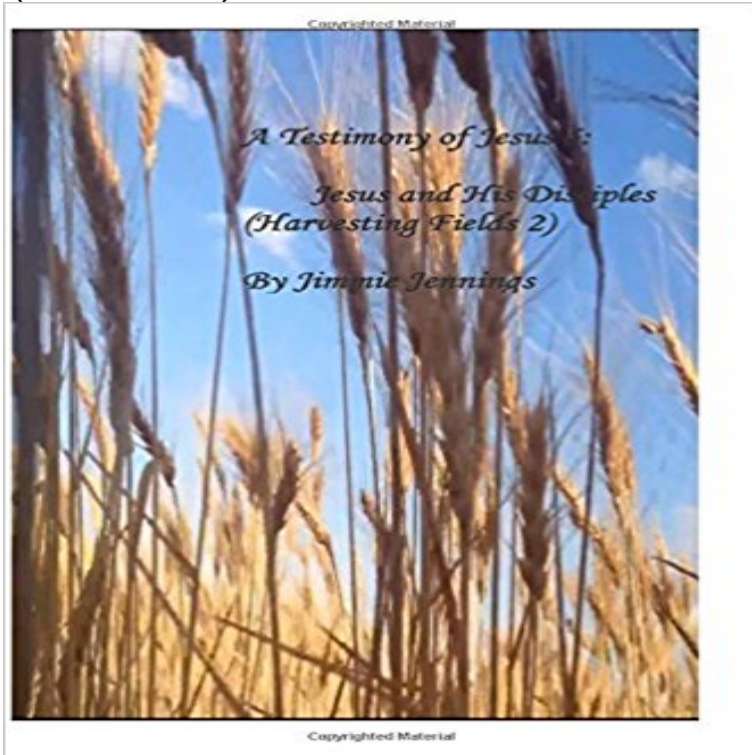


A Testimony of Jesus 5: Jesus and His Disciples (Harvesting Fields 2) (Volume 5)
