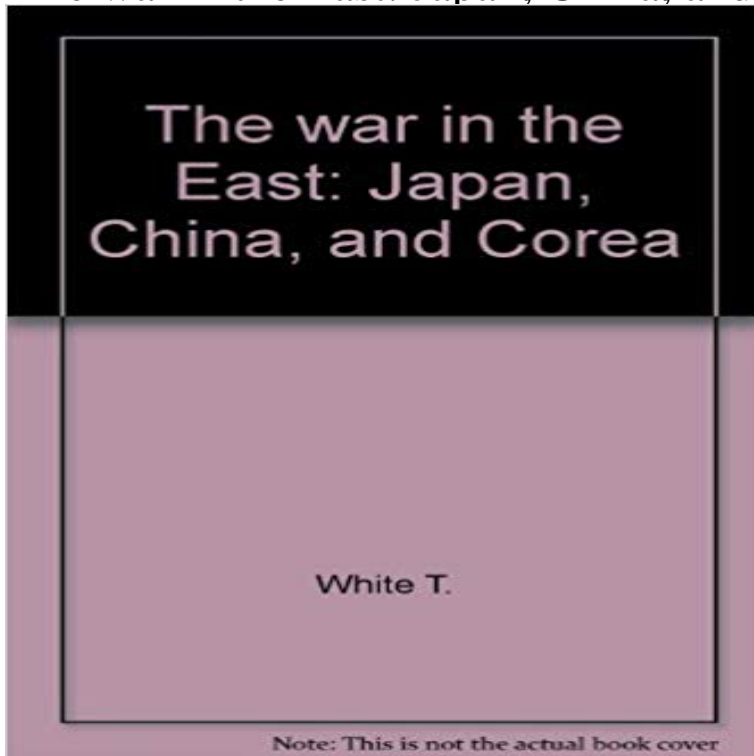


The war in the East: Japan, China, and Corea
