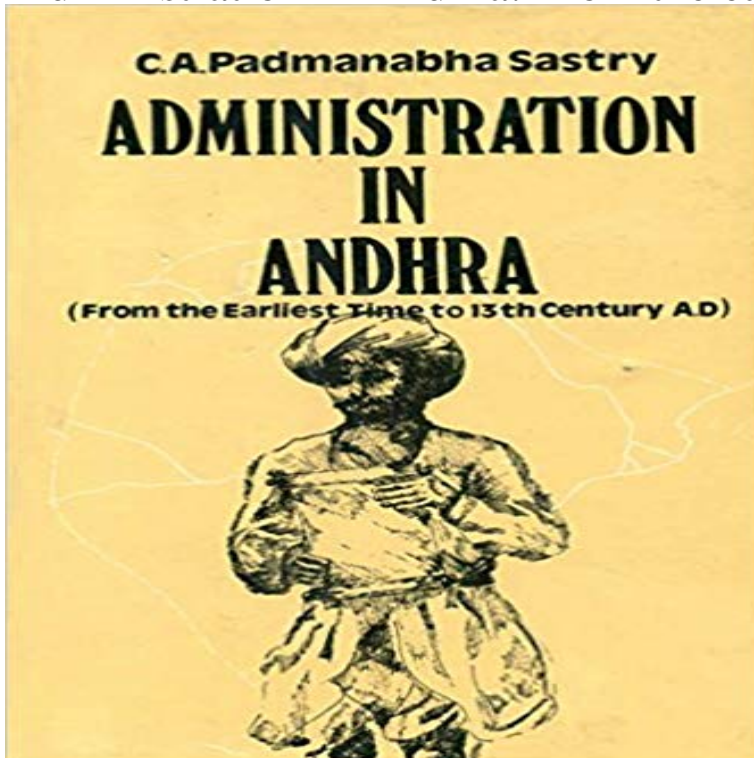


## Administration in Andhra: From the earliest times to 13th century A.D
