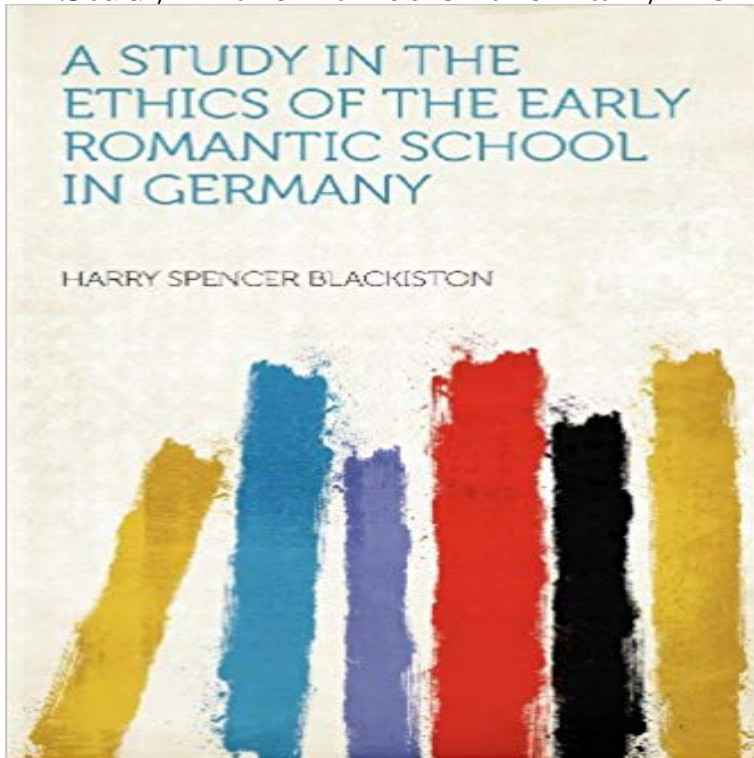


## A Study in the Ethics of the Early Romantic School in Germany
