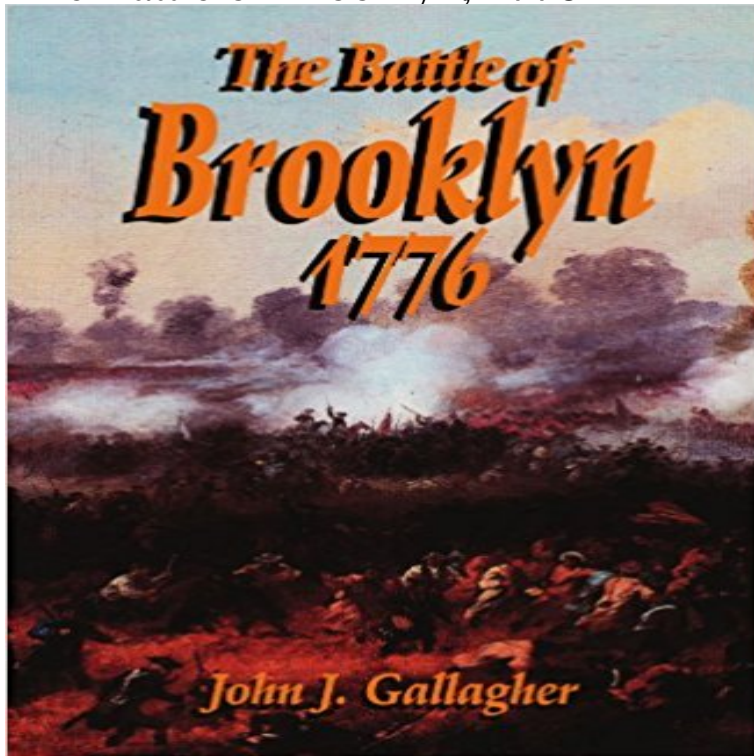


## The Battle of Brooklyn, 1776
