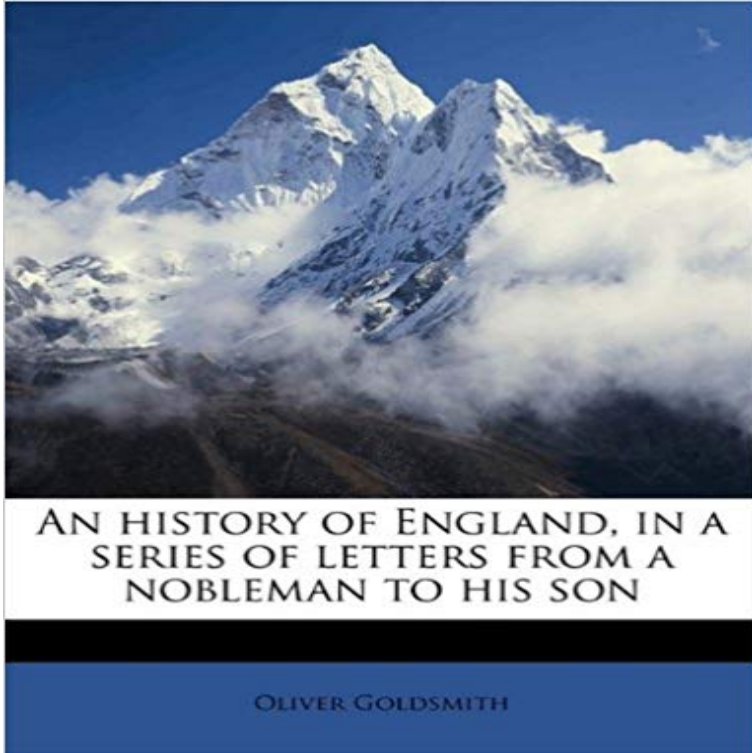


# An history of England, in a series of letters from a nobleman to his son Volume 1
