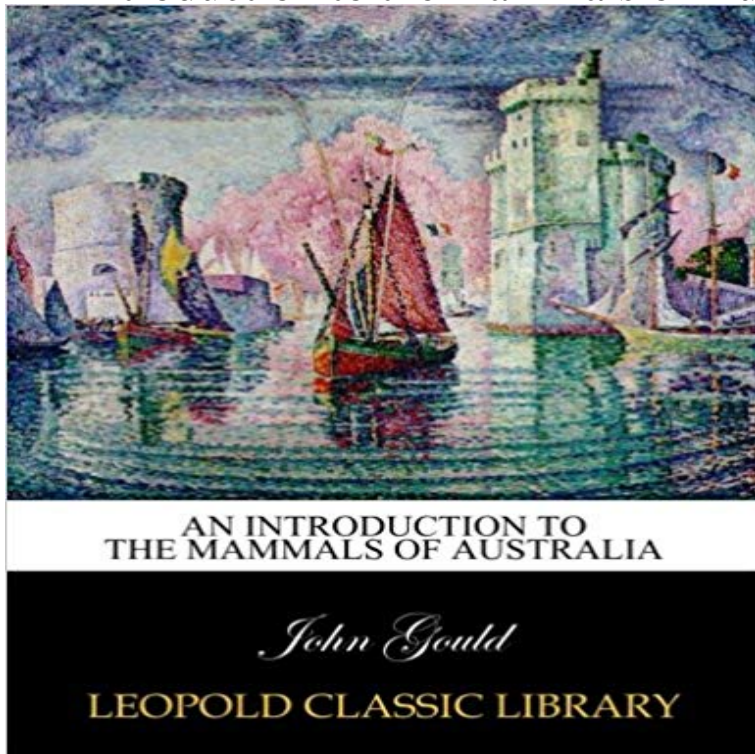


An introduction to the mammals of Australia
