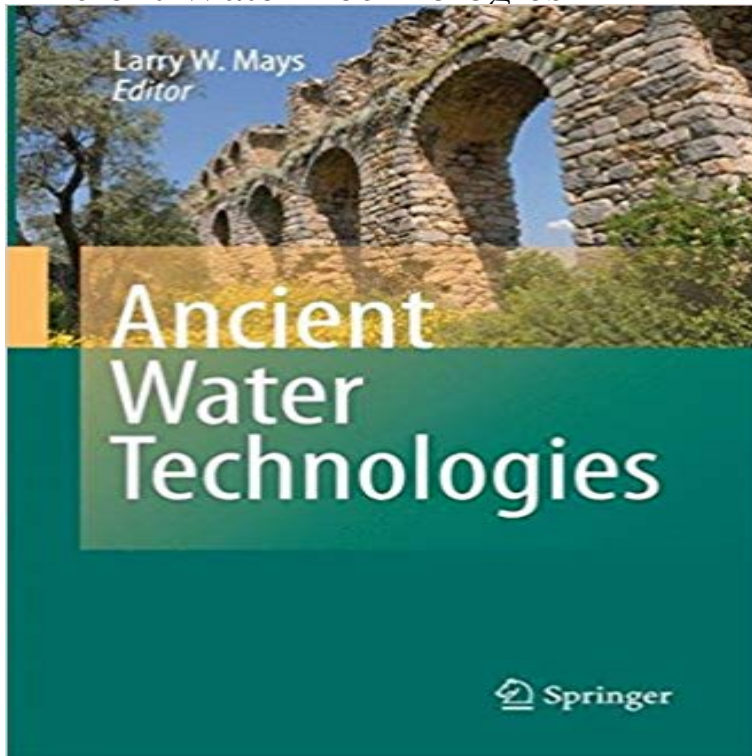


## Ancient Water Technologies
