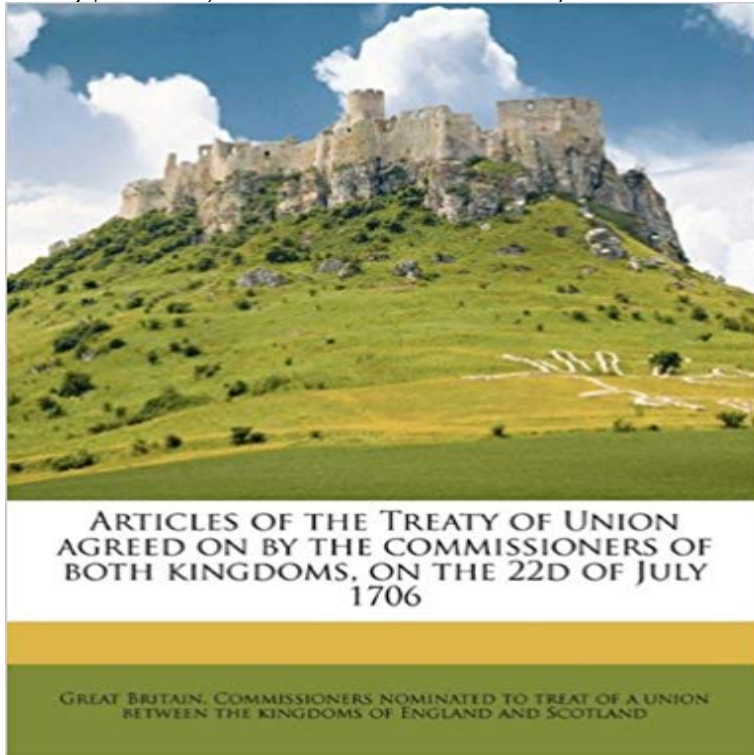


Articles of the Treaty of Union agreed on by the commissioners of both kingdoms, on the 22d of July 1706
