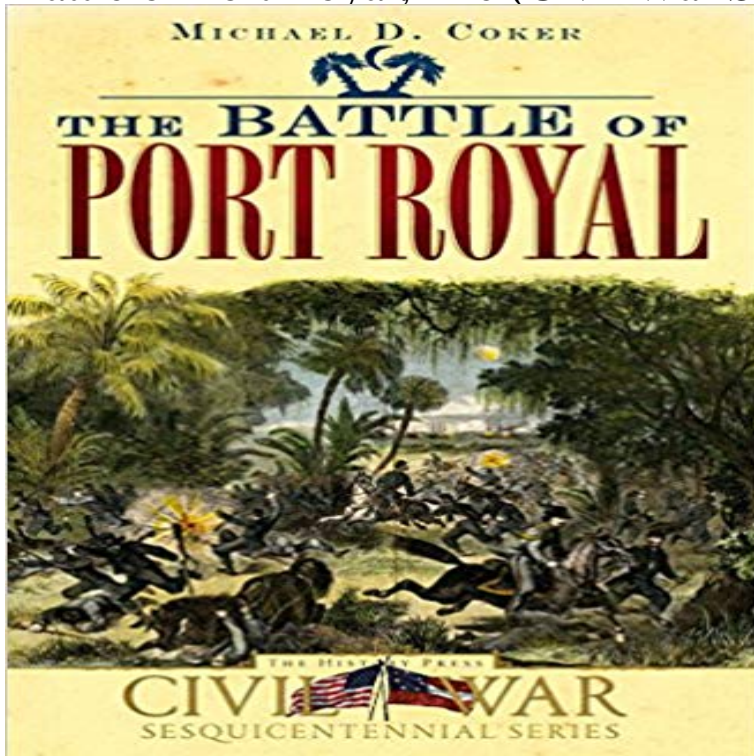


## Battle of Port Royal, The (Civil War Series)



November 1861. The South was winning the Civil War. Fort Sumter had fallen to the Confederates. The Federal army was routed at Manassas.
