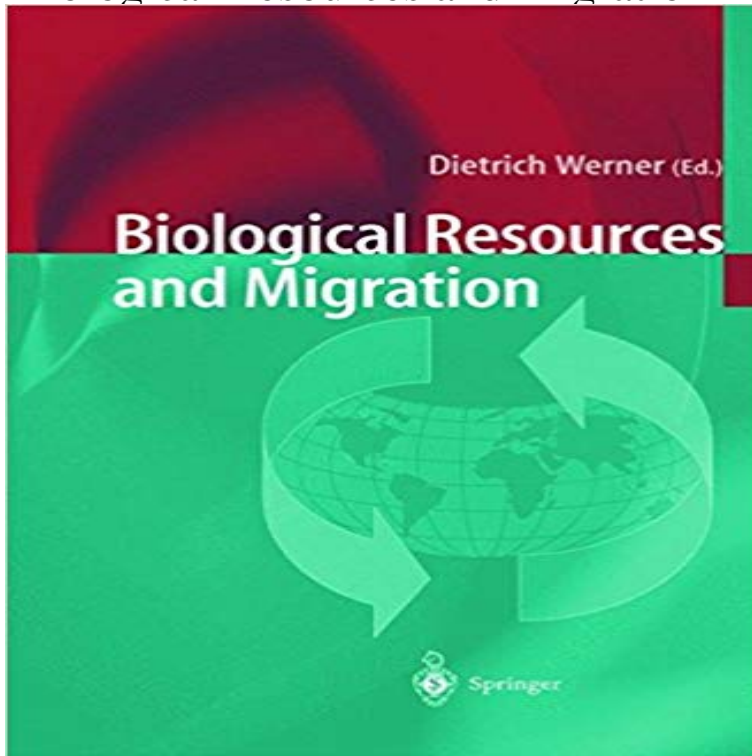


Biological Resources and Migration
