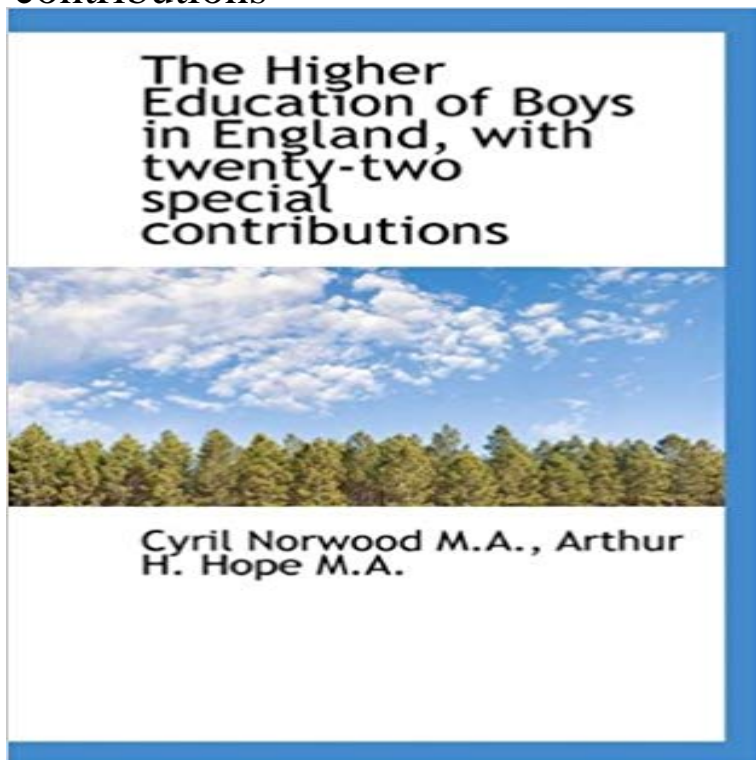


The Higher Education of Boys in England, with twenty-two special contributions
