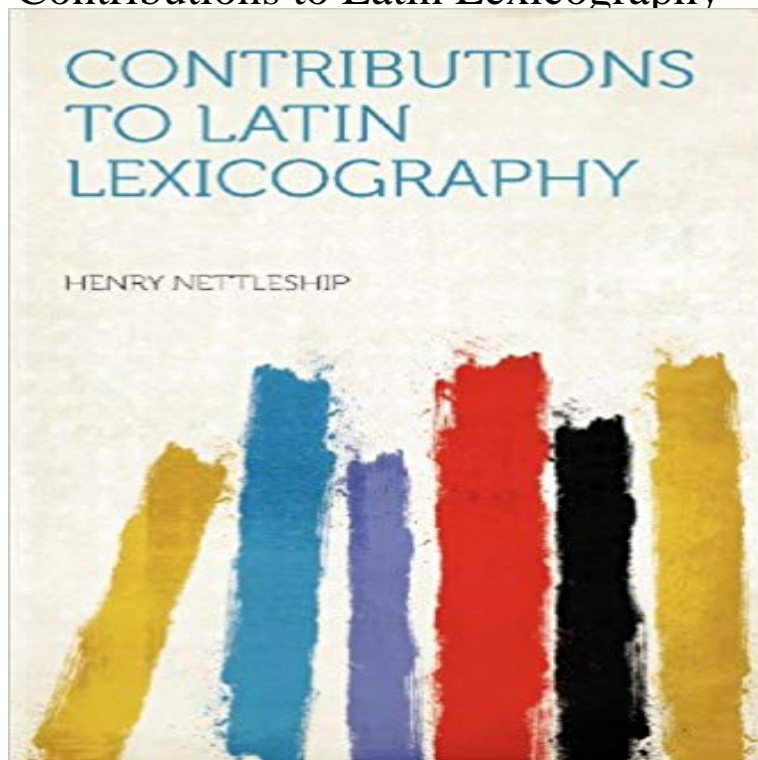


Contributions to Latin Lexicography
