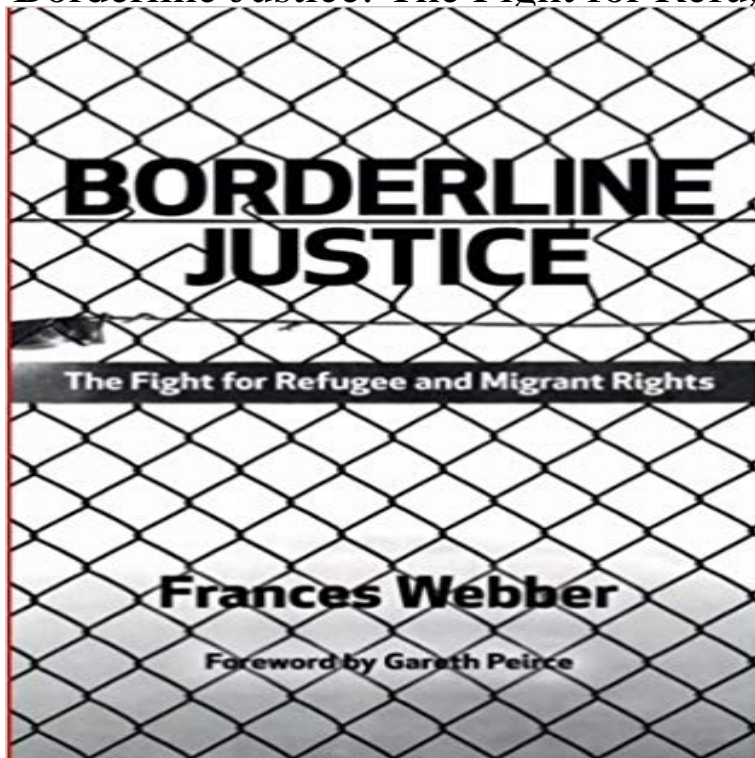


Borderline Justice: The Fight for Refugee and Migrant Rights
