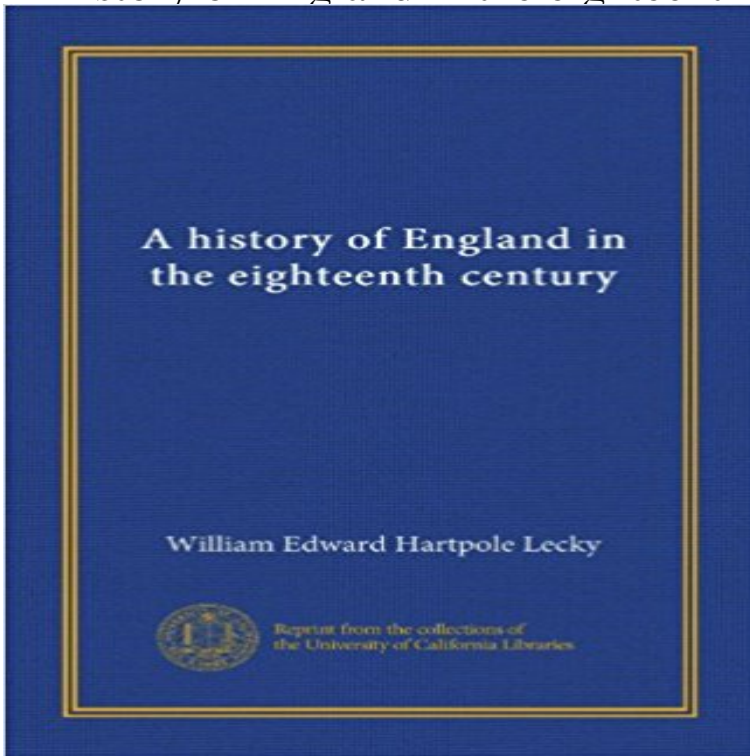


A history of England in the eighteenth century (v.8)
