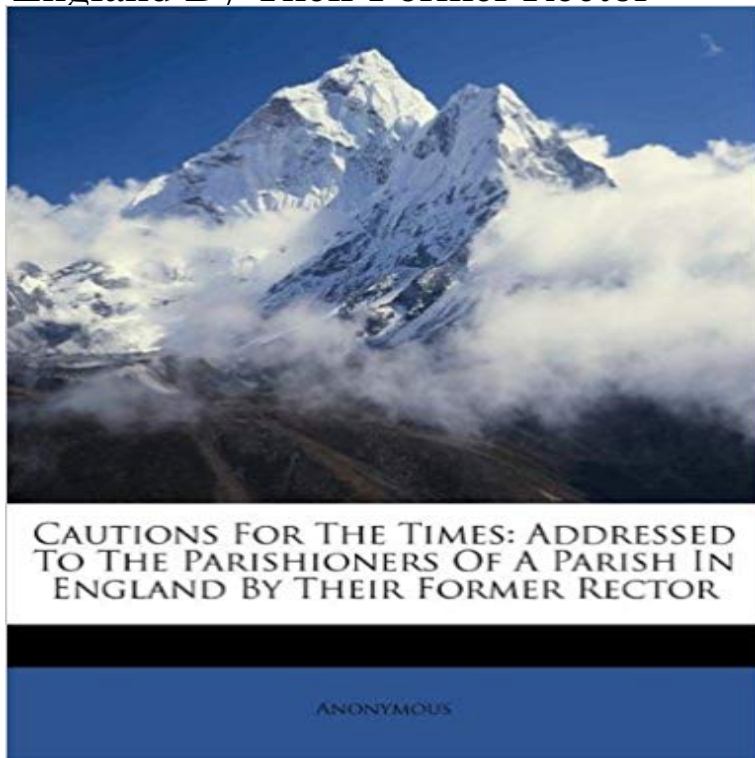


Cautions For The Times: Addressed To The Parishioners Of A Parish In England By Their Former Rector
