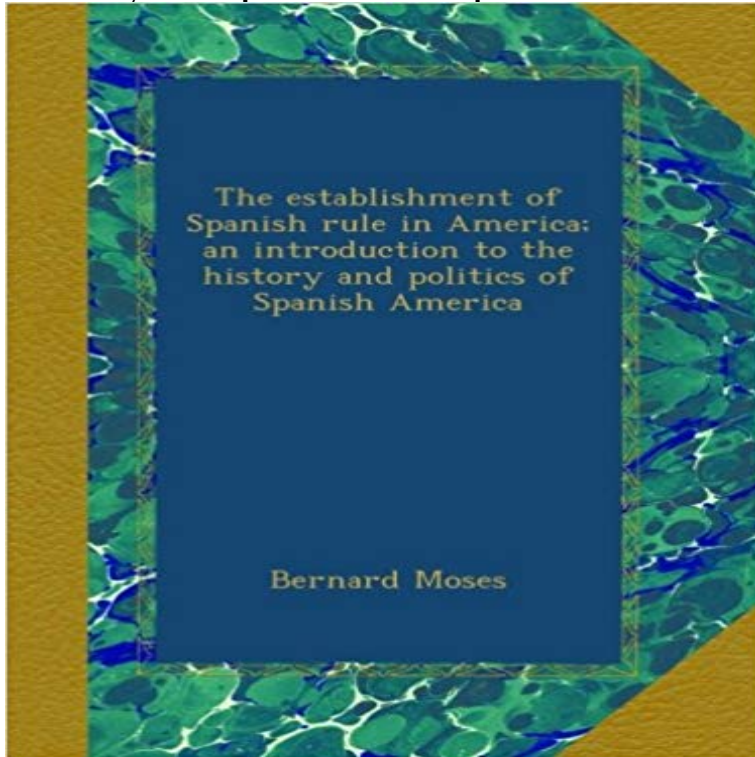


The establishment of Spanish rule in America; an introduction to the history and politics of Spanish America
