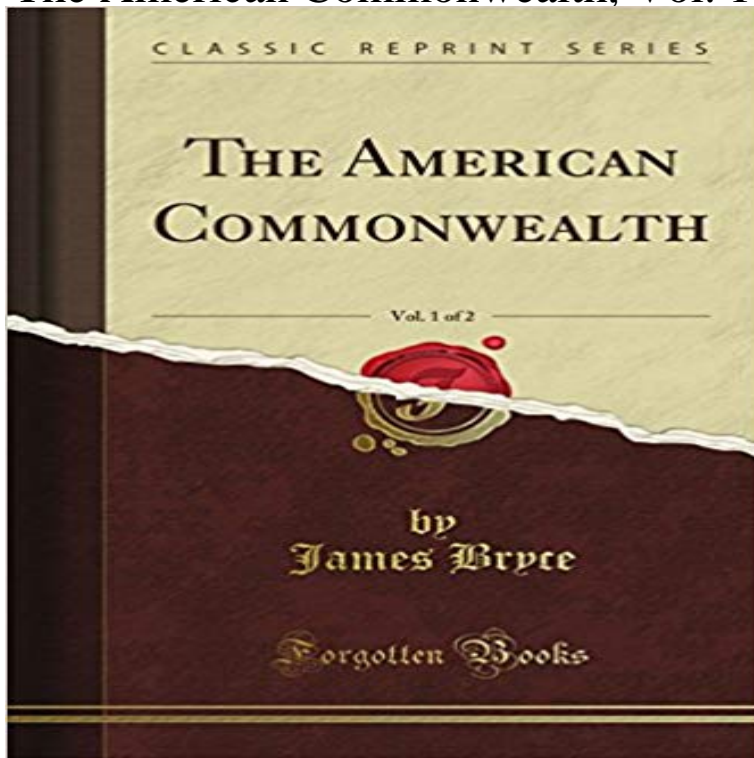


The American Commonwealth, Vol. 1 of 2 (Classic Reprint)
