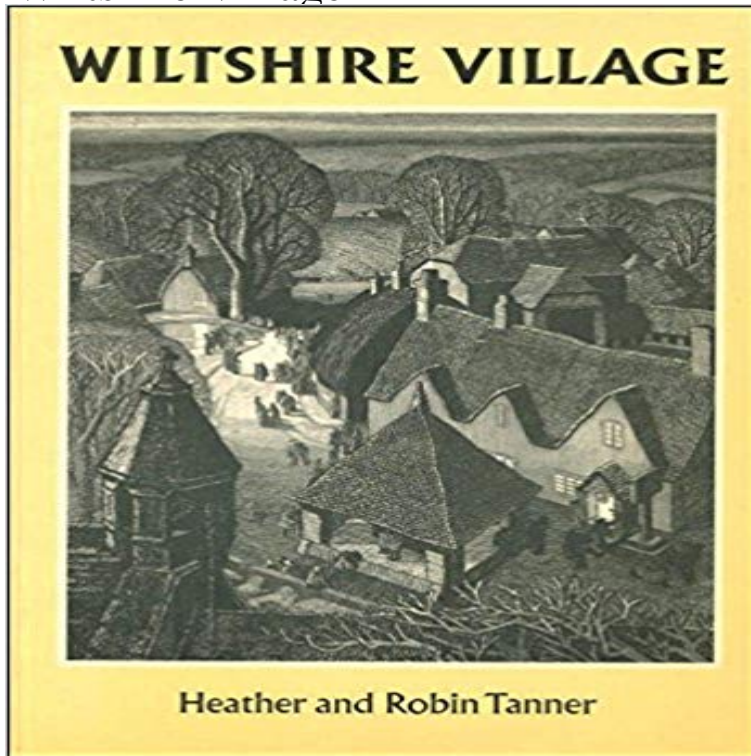


Wiltshire Village
