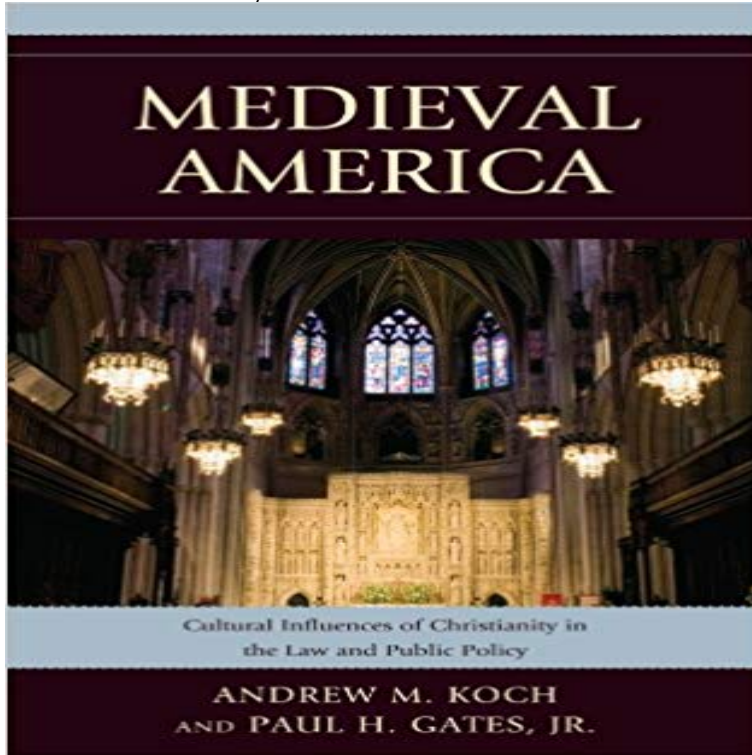


Medieval America: Cultural Influences of Christianity in the Law and Public Policy
