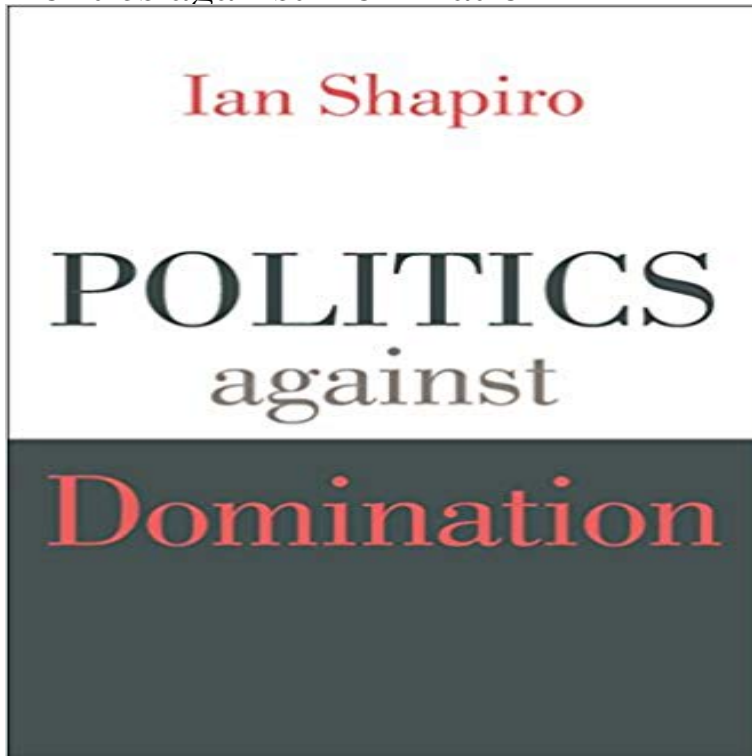


## Politics against Domination
