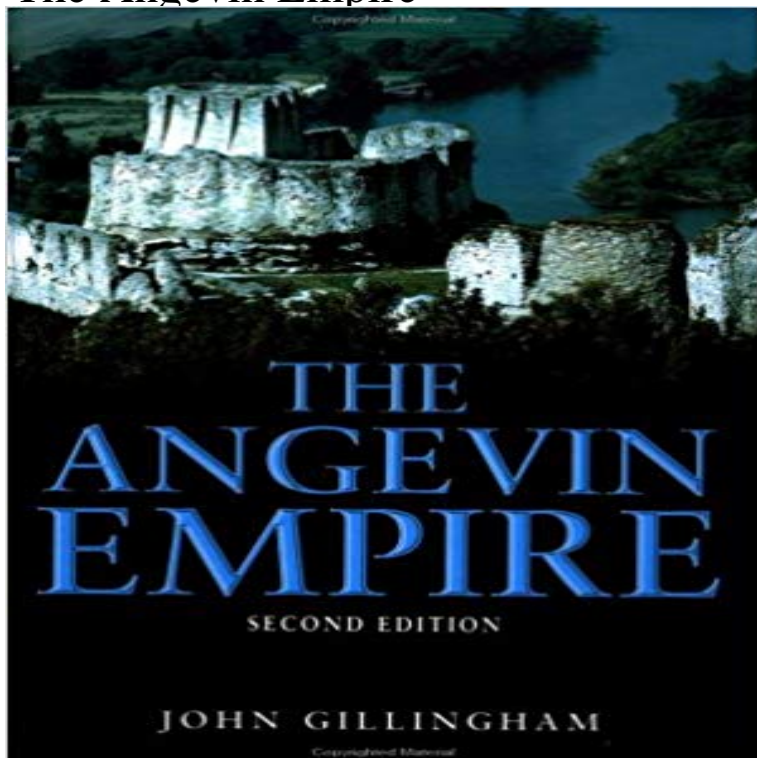


The Angevin Empire
