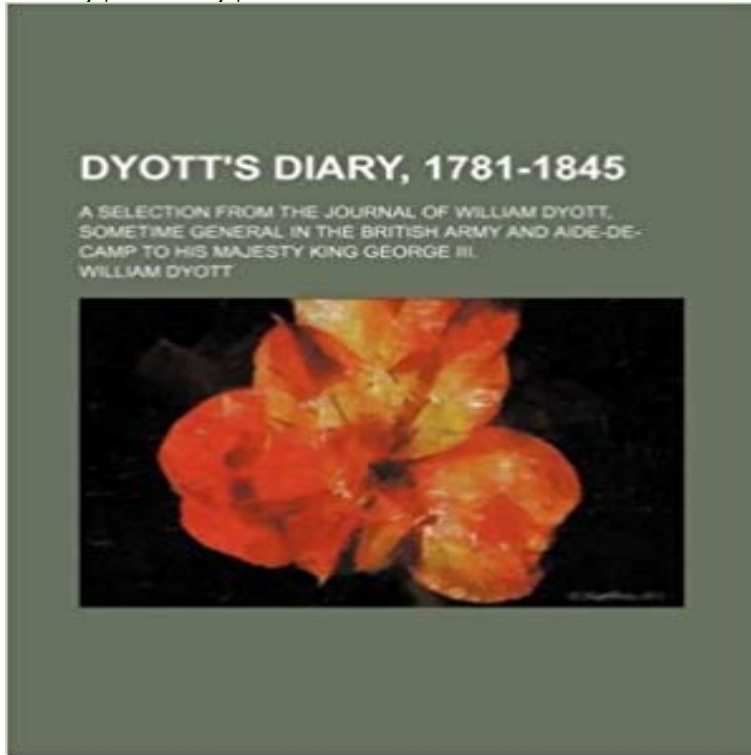

I met him walking with his aide-de-camp; he appeared about sixty years of age, and really looked more like an English miller than a French general. The houses of modern Alexandria seem to have been built from the ruins of the old town like the walls, as there is not the smallest appearance of the grandeur that ornamented the more ancient buildings. The day was most suffocatingly hot, and as I rode about the place for three or four hours, I was perfectly fagged. 12th.--Paid another visit to Alexandria; there is no greater curiosity than the cisterns for supplying the place with water, which are filled at the rising of the Nile by means of the famous canal made by Alexander at the time the city was built. The intention of the canal was not only for supplying water, but was also for the purpose of navigation inland from the Nile. The cisterns are of immense extent, and inside have more the appearance of the inside of a very large cathedral than anything I could compare them to. They extend under the whole of the space within the old wall and are found in different places outside the walls, and no doubt the whole of the ancient town was supplied in like manner. During the time we were besieging Alexandria, it was thought expedient to make a cut through the canal in order to inundate the country, by which means the usual supply of water for filling the cisterns was prevented reaching the place. The consequence was that they were
