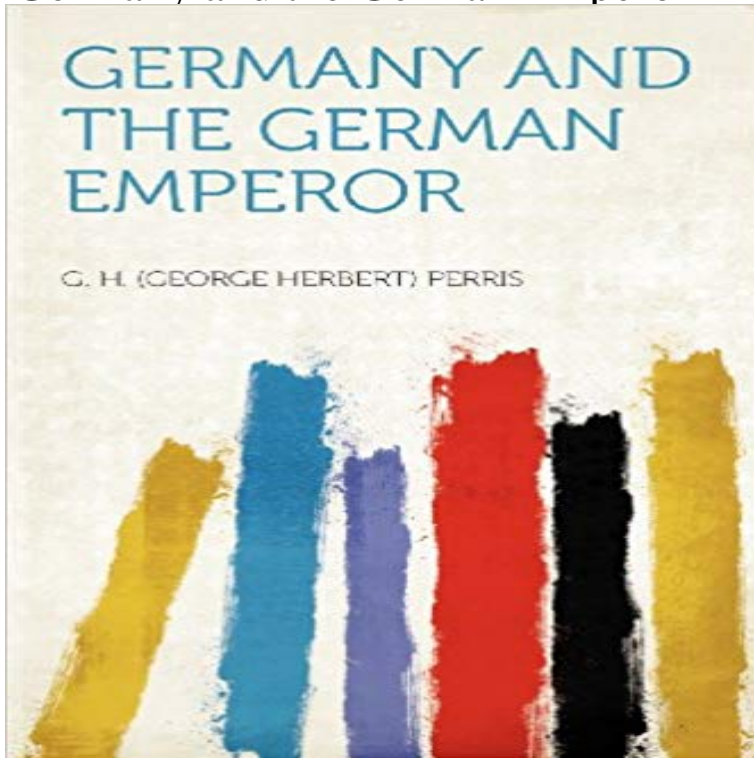


## Germany and the German Emperor
