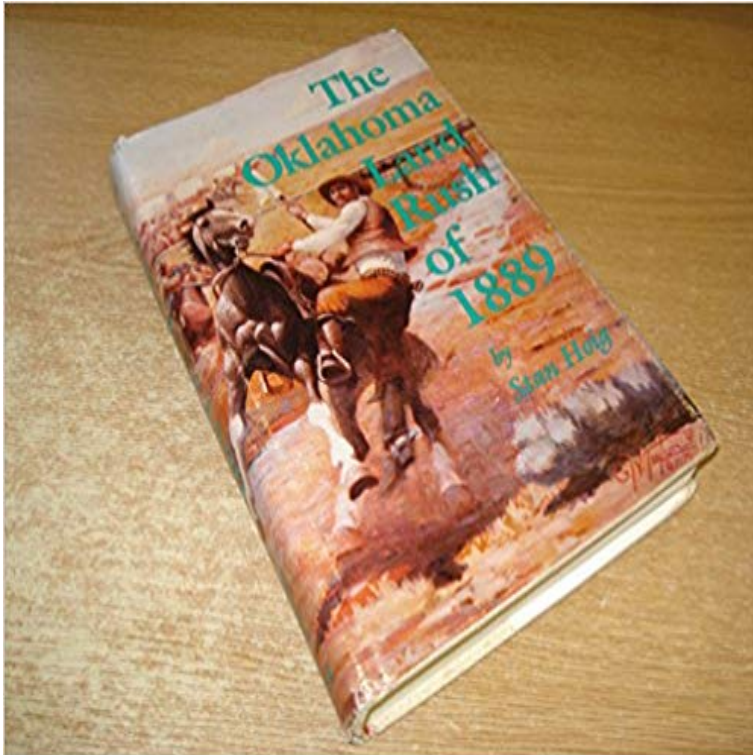


The Oklahoma Land Rush of 1889
