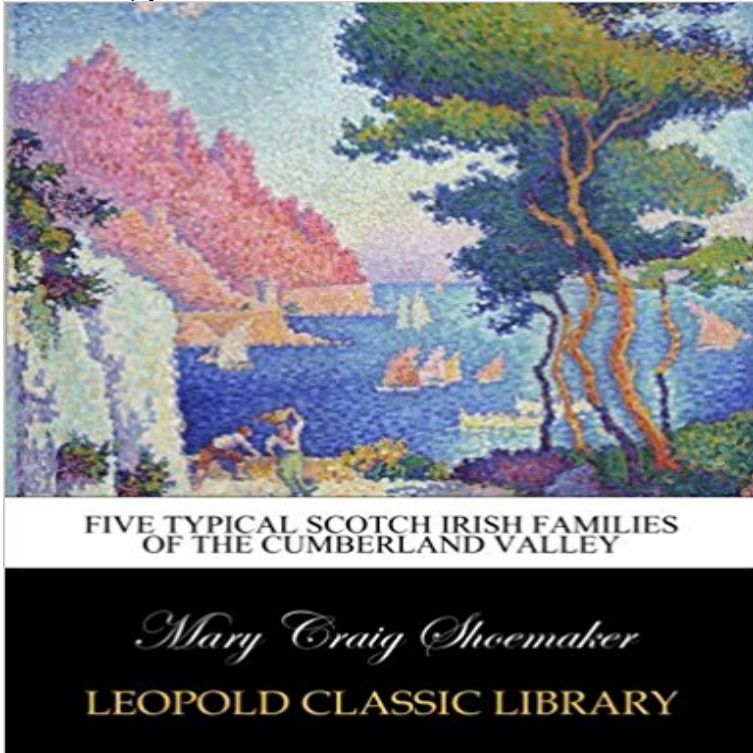


## Five typical Scotch Irish families of the Cumberland Valley
