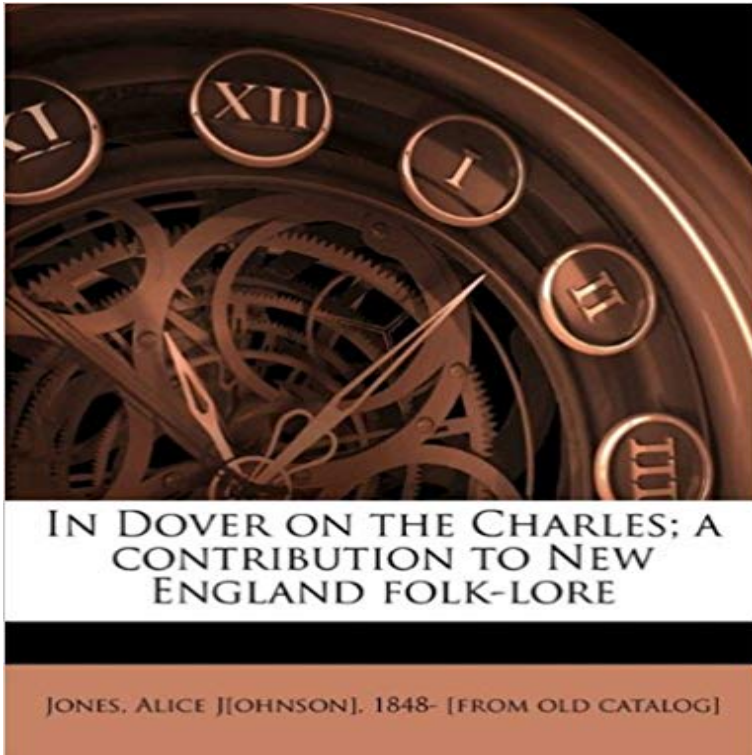


# In Dover on the Charles; a contribution to New England folk-lore Volume 1
