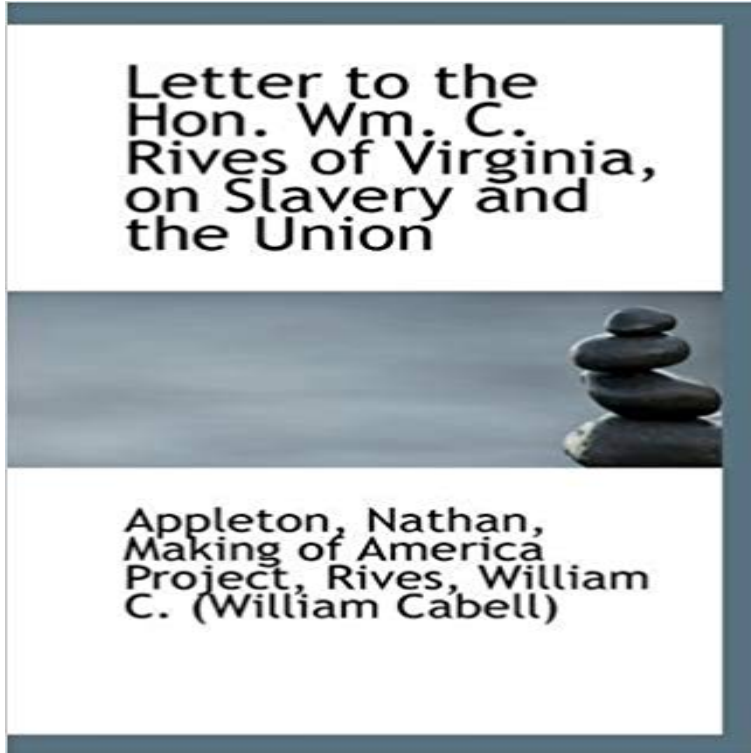


Letter to the Hon. Wm. C. Rives of Virginia, on Slavery and the Union
