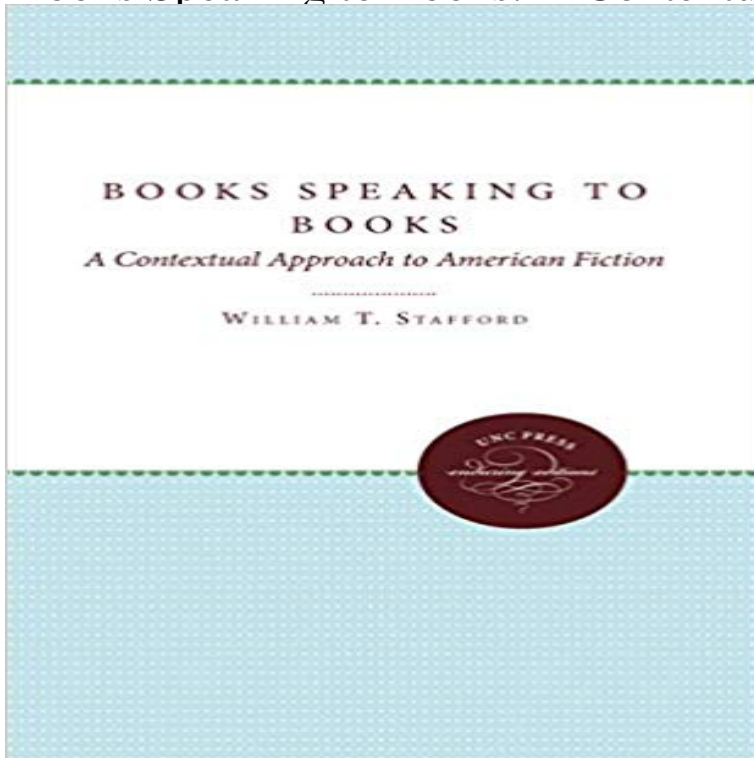


Books Speaking to Books: A Contextual Approach to American Fiction



Stafford introduces the rich interpretive possibilities in a contextual analysis of literature. He finds in *Moby Dick*, *The Wings of the Dove*, and *Absalom, Absalom!* three symbolic Americas linked through images of whiteness that are collectively prophetic. Three novels of the 1920s (by Faulkner, Hemingway, and Fitzgerald) are linked by themes of innocence; three of the 1970s (by Bellows, Malamud, and Updike), by black-white pairs.
