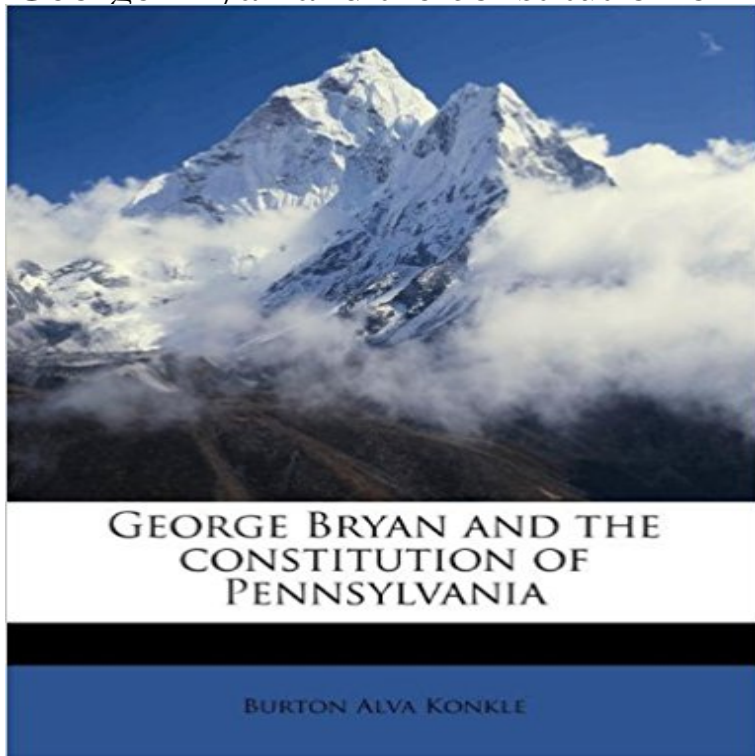


George Bryan and the constitution of Pennsylvania
