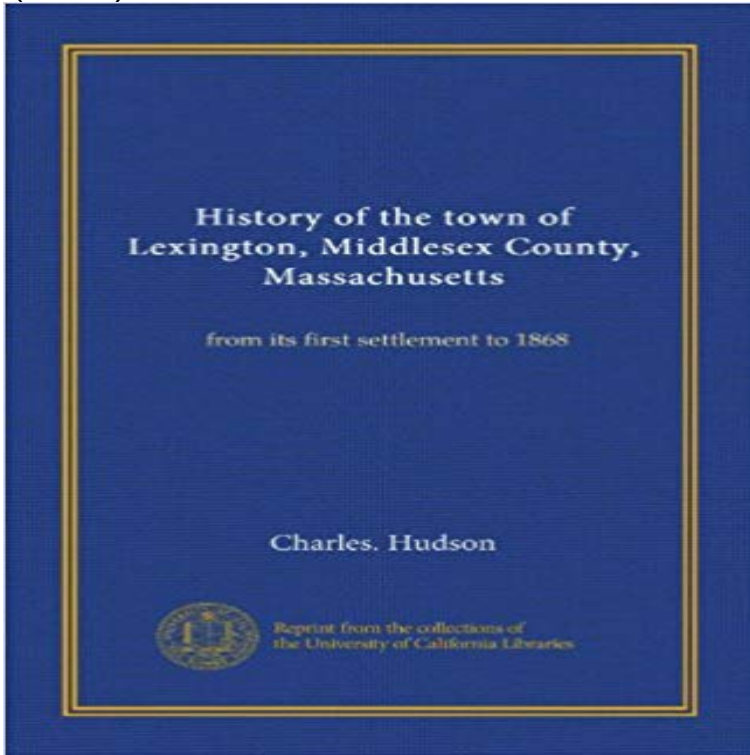


History of the town of Lexington, Middlesex County, Massachusetts (v.01): from its first settlement to 1868
