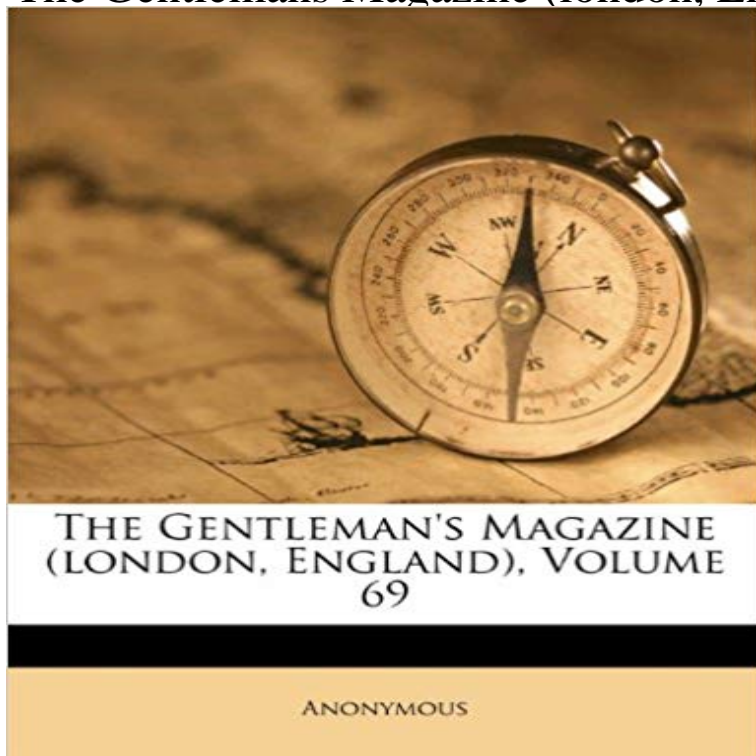


The Gentlemans Magazine (london, England), Volume 69
