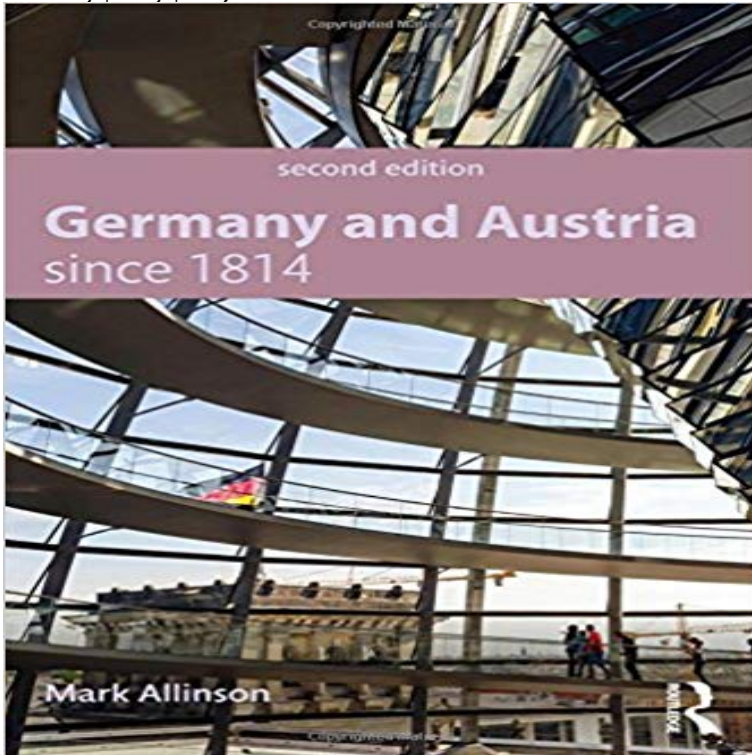


Germany and Austria since 1814 (Modern History for Modern Languages)
