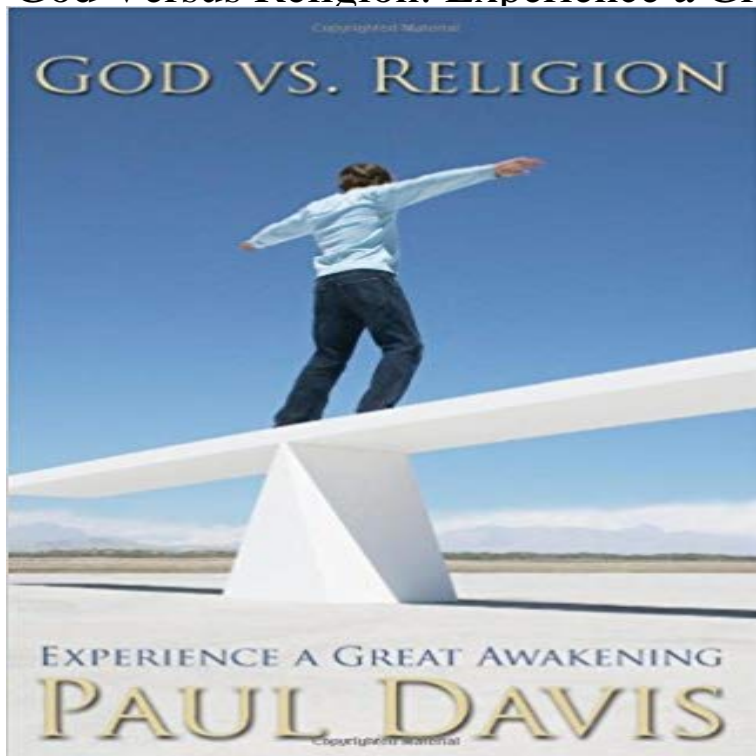


God Versus Religion: Experience a Great Awakening

Davis not only shares his personal experiences but warns against the way religion: * Misrepresents God * Fosters the erroneous human tendency toward self-sufficiency * Promotes satanic counterfeits * Preys on those who lack knowledge of truth * Pushes rigid rules * Accuses and condemns * Exalts presents of temporal value over Gods presence * Denies the ministry of Spirit and truth * Substitutes futile works for a God-initiated relationship * Holds people in lifeless, loveless bondage Religion, says Davis, is Gods enemy, mans crutch, and Satans deception. Gods desire for us to is to enjoy spending time with Him in His presence. Knowing God and having a relationship with Him is not boring. Instead, it brings joy.
