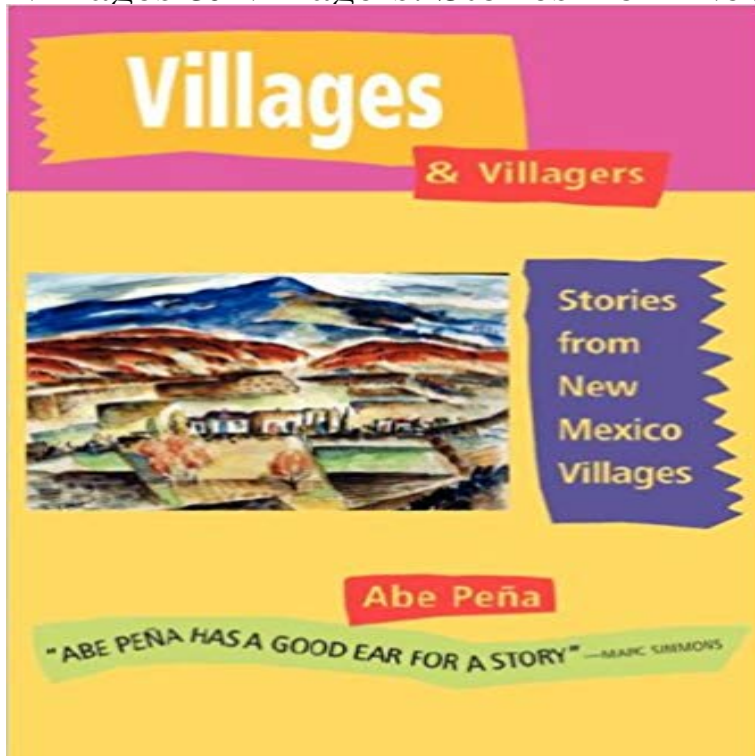


Villages & Villagers: Stories from New Mexico Villages
