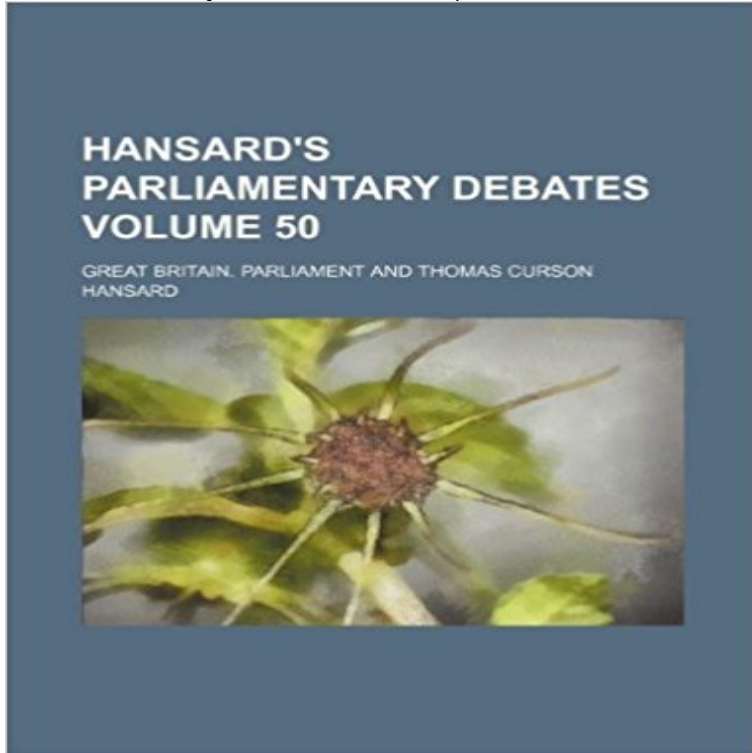

If he was asked why he took this course at the present moment, and why he did not endeavour to persevere, however ineffectual the attempt might be for some days to come, he would say, that if he thought he could thus attain the object, it would be something certainly; but if he unnecessarily protracted the Session for a fortnight longer, the public might become more indifferent to the injustice of the opposition than if he were to leave the case as it stood.
