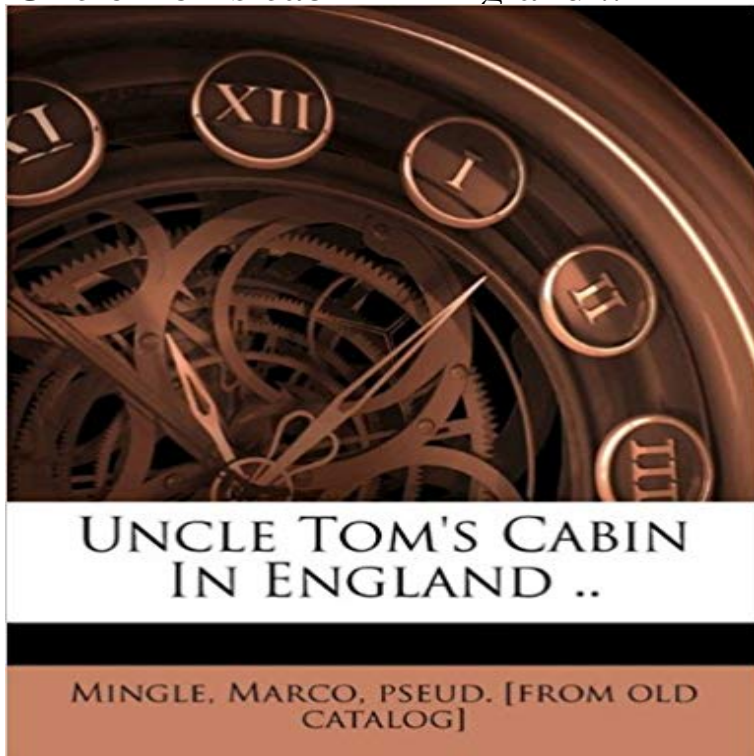


Uncle Toms cabin in England ..
