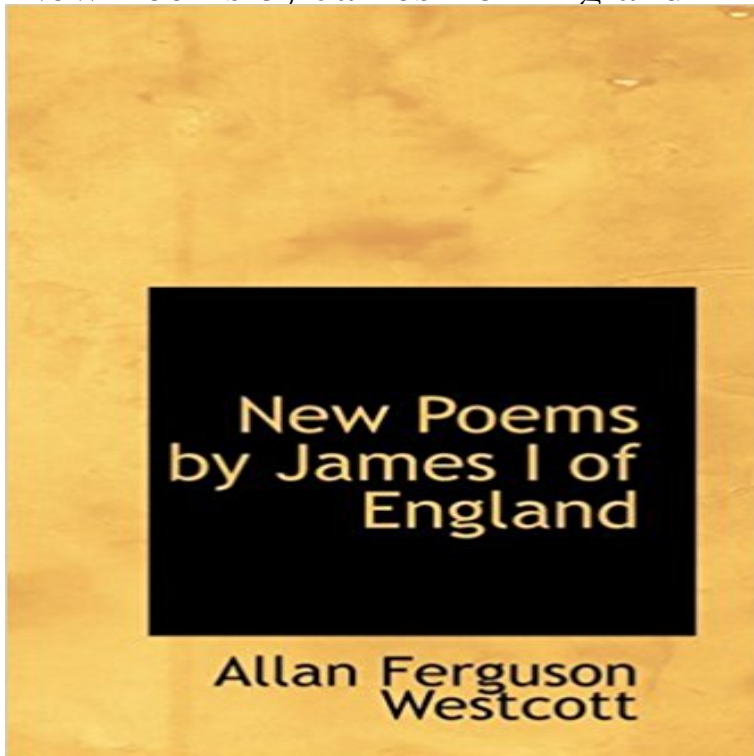


## New Poems by James I of England
