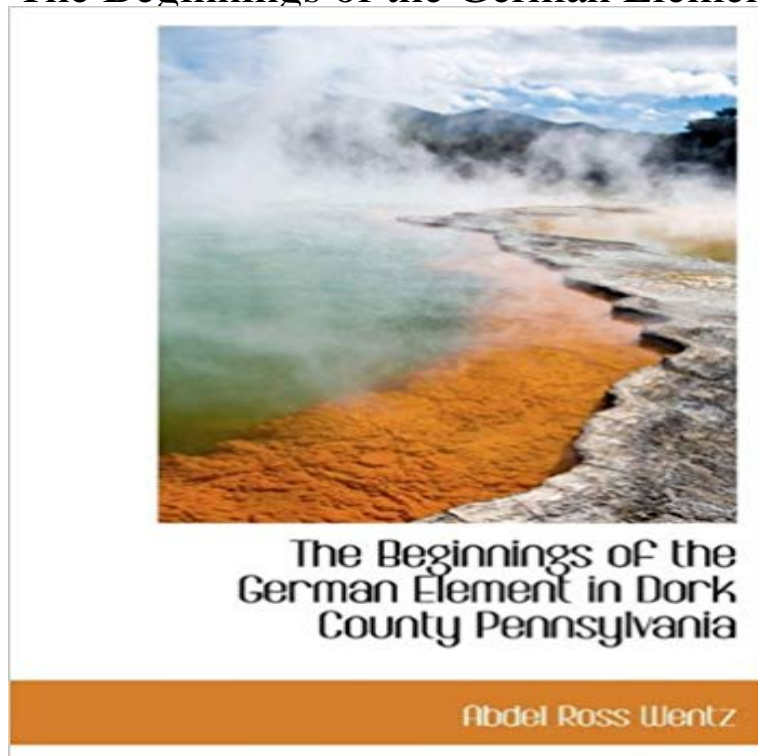


The Beginnings of the German Element in Dork County Pennsylvania
