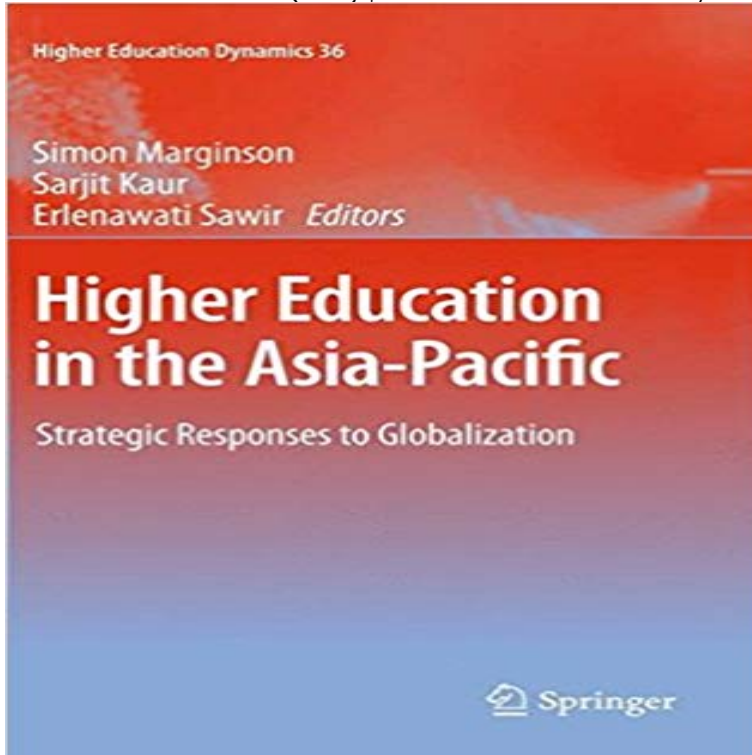


Higher Education in the Asia-Pacific: Strategic Responses to Globalization (Higher Education Dynamics)
