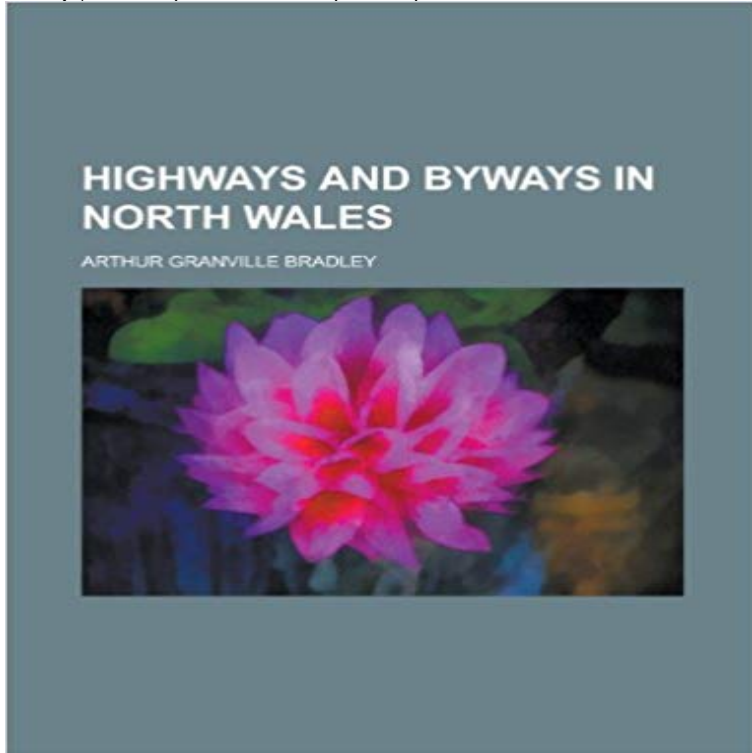


## Highways and byways in North Wales

That a select few afford a sharp and brilliant contrast to this studied dulness, only emphasises a fact which these notable exceptions are themselves among the first to admit and deplore. Welsh history for the average Nonconformist begins with the Methodist revival, with Howell Harris, Rowlands, and Charles of Bala. Noble men beyond a doubt, who did great and noble work in the last century and later, when, thanks in the main to Anglican misgovernment, the Welsh Church was in a lamentable and parlous state. But the history of their successors is not especially inspiring. Nor are chapel statistics and sectarian rivalries the kind of interests to be absorbingly cultivated without producing a mental atmosphere that seems all ajar with the physical beauties and romantic past of Wales. Thank God we have outgrown these superstitions, is a common retort of the Country minister to any expression of regret at this indifference.
