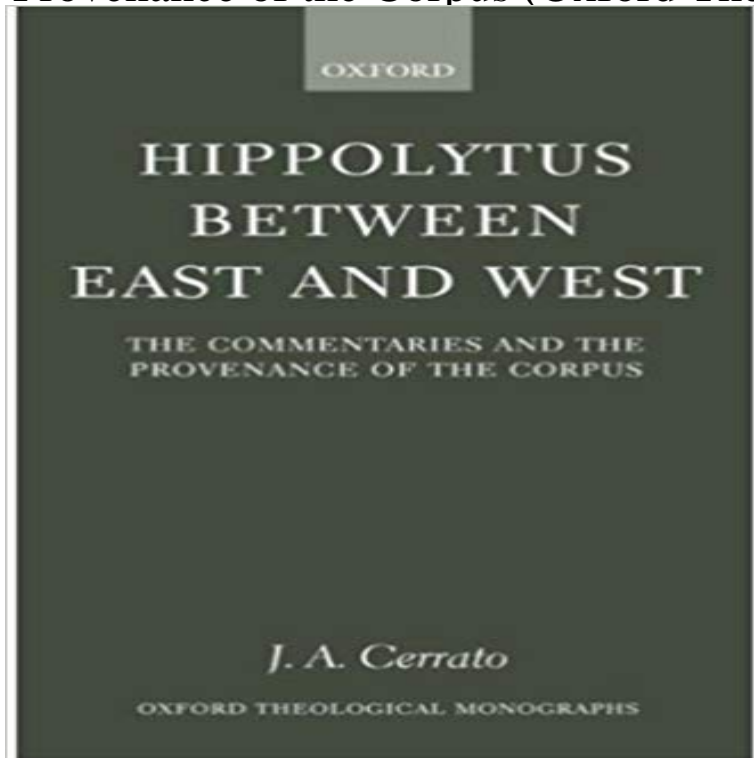


Hippolytus between East and West: The Commentaries and the Provenance of the Corpus (Oxford Theology and Religion Monographs)
