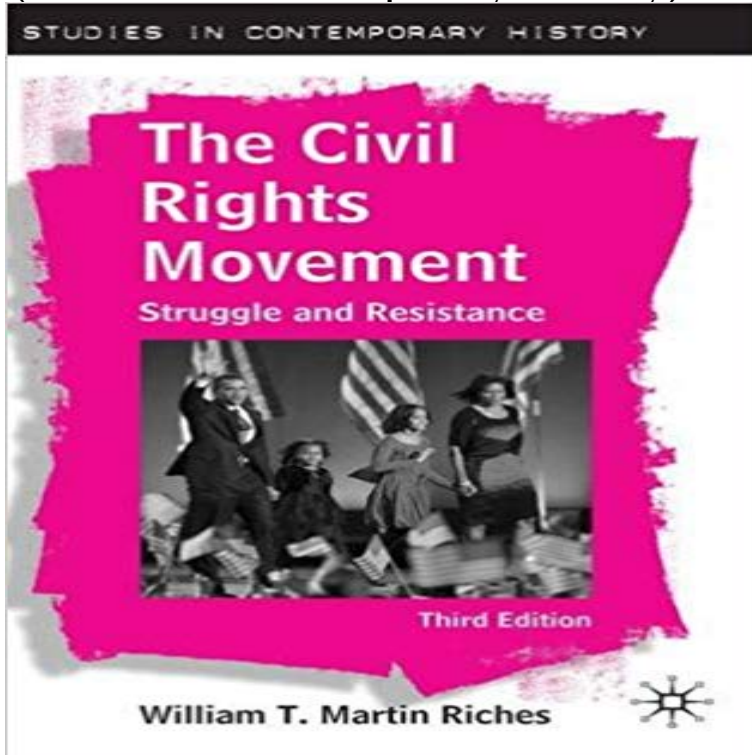


## The Civil Rights Movement: Struggle and Resistance, Third Edition (Studies in Contemporary History)

Riches emphasizes how the movement influenced others seeking justice in America, and evaluates the coalitions formed to preserve gains threatened by the rise of the New Right.
