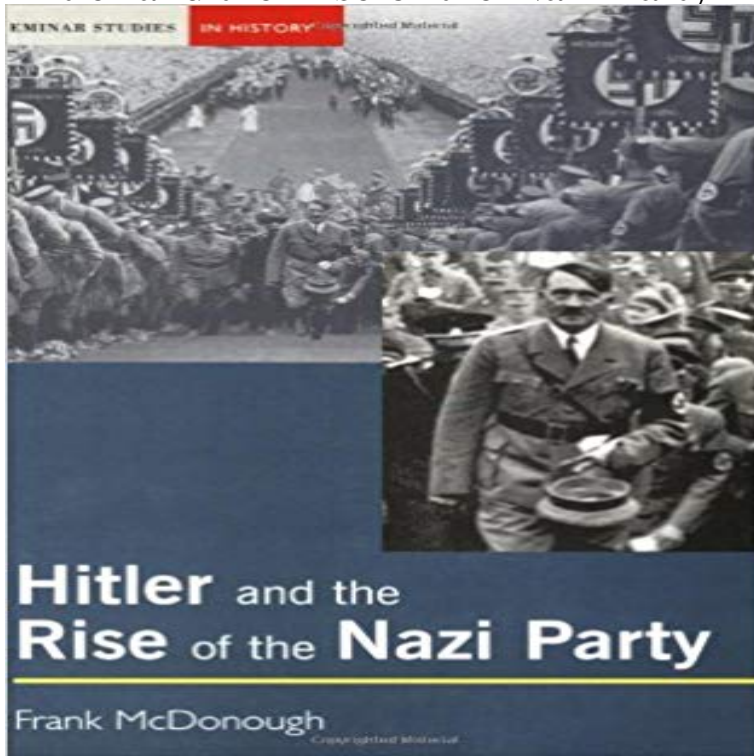


Hitler and the Rise of the Nazi Party
