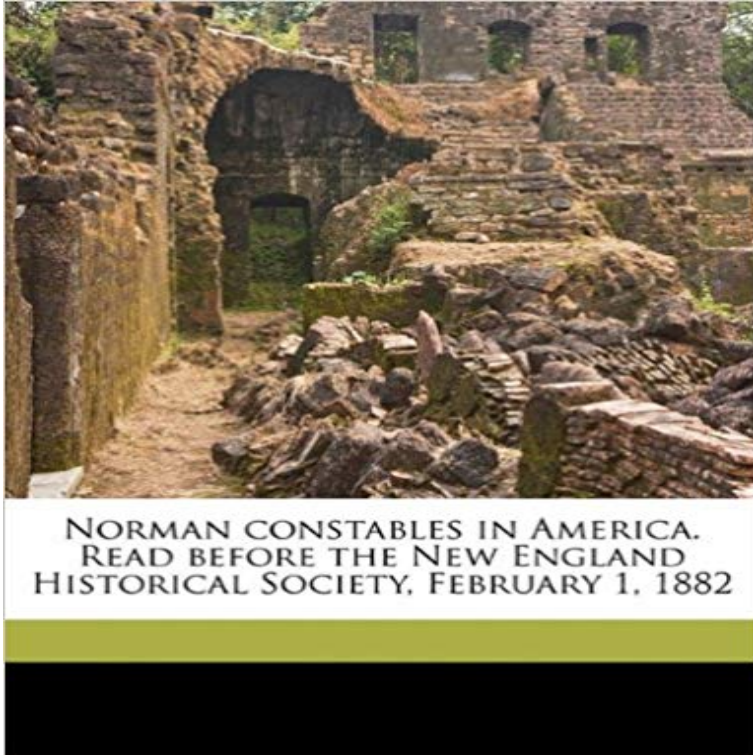


## Norman constables in America. Read before the New England Historical Society, February 1, 1882
