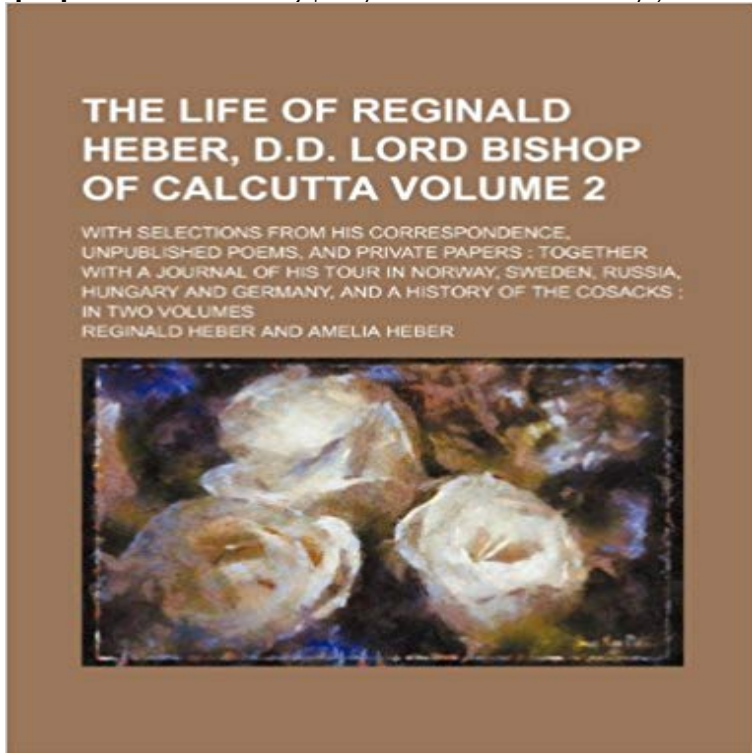

It has now been found, on a full and fair trial, that the indispensable expenditure of the College, without including the charges of building, of medical attendance, or the expences of the mission at Boglipoor, is about eleven hundred and eighty sicca rupees per month, or 1,416/. per annum. To meet this great expenditure we have no resources but the interest of the sum in the treasury of Bengal, amounting to 300/. and the allowance of 50/. yearly made to each of their students by the Incorporated Society, that for Promoting Christian Knowledge, and the Church Missionary Society,--amounting for the past year, to 200/. more. The splendid present of 1000/. which we last year received from the Church Missionary Society, has enabled the Principal to get through thus far without contracting debt. But not only are we without any positive assurance that this grant will, in future years, be continued to us, but there is every probability that, if it is continued, we shall be directed to apply it to the foundation of scholarships, rather than to the general purposes and incidental expenses of the establishment. And though I am encouraged to hope, by the splendid example set in Bombay, that the amount of subscriptions which may be raised in the different provinces of India, will not fall short of five thousand sicca rupees, or 500/. a year, yet I am too well acquainted with the fluctuating nature of Indian society, with the rival claims which are continually arising on the benevolence of the Indian public, and with the fact xxvi. 1825. that all the religious and charitable funds
