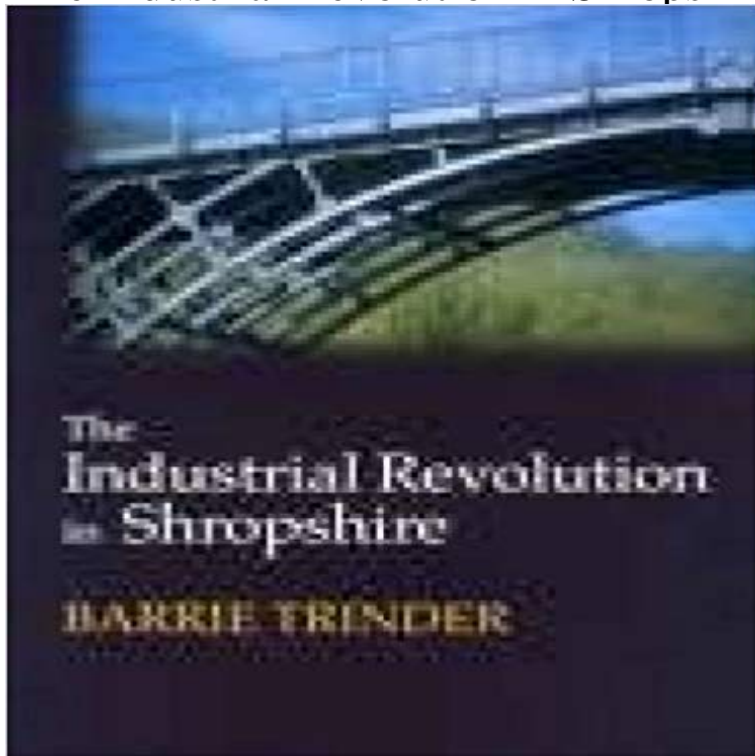


The Industrial Revolution in Shropshire
