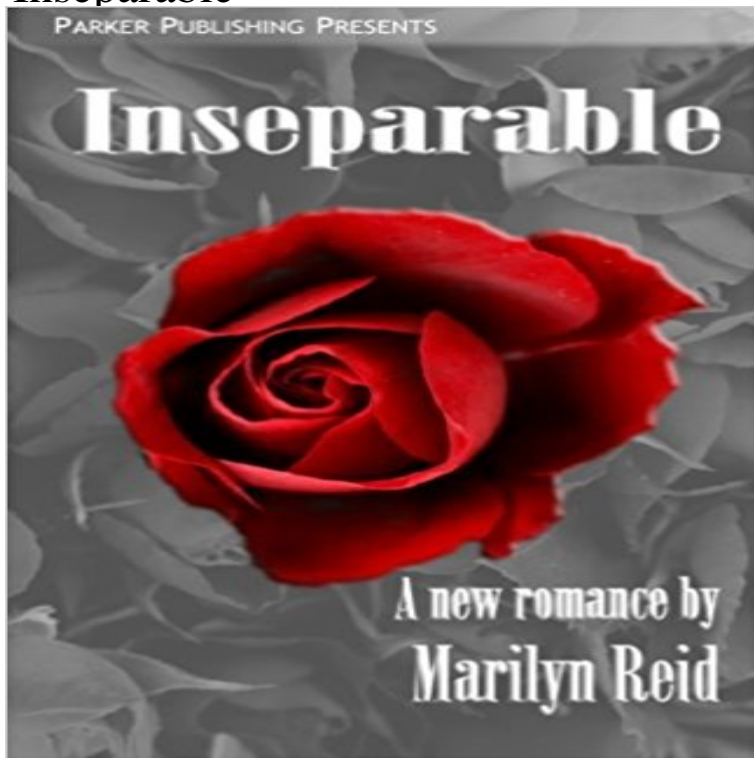


Inseparable
